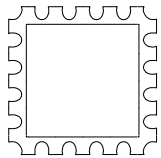

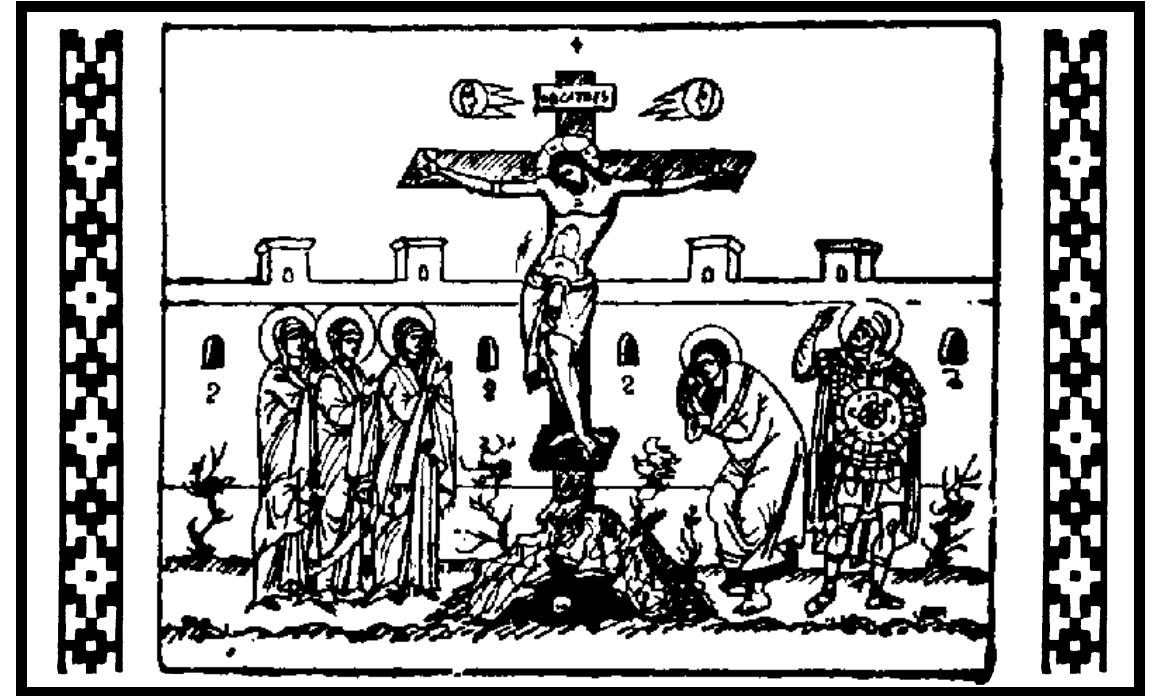

A Lenten Reminder For All Orthodox Christians: We are called to prepare for the celebration of Pascha during this Lenten Fast in a special way. In addition to increased prayer, fasting, and charitable

We should take the time to prepare and make a Confession of our sins in preparation for the Paschal celebration in a spirit of genuine repentance, not just as some obligation because we were told to do it. Father will be available for Confession before and after every service during Great Lent. Please make every effort to take advantage of this! Also, for those preparing to receive Holy Communion for the Presanctified Liturgy, please begin your fast after the noon hour, as well as saying your usual pre-communion prayers.
