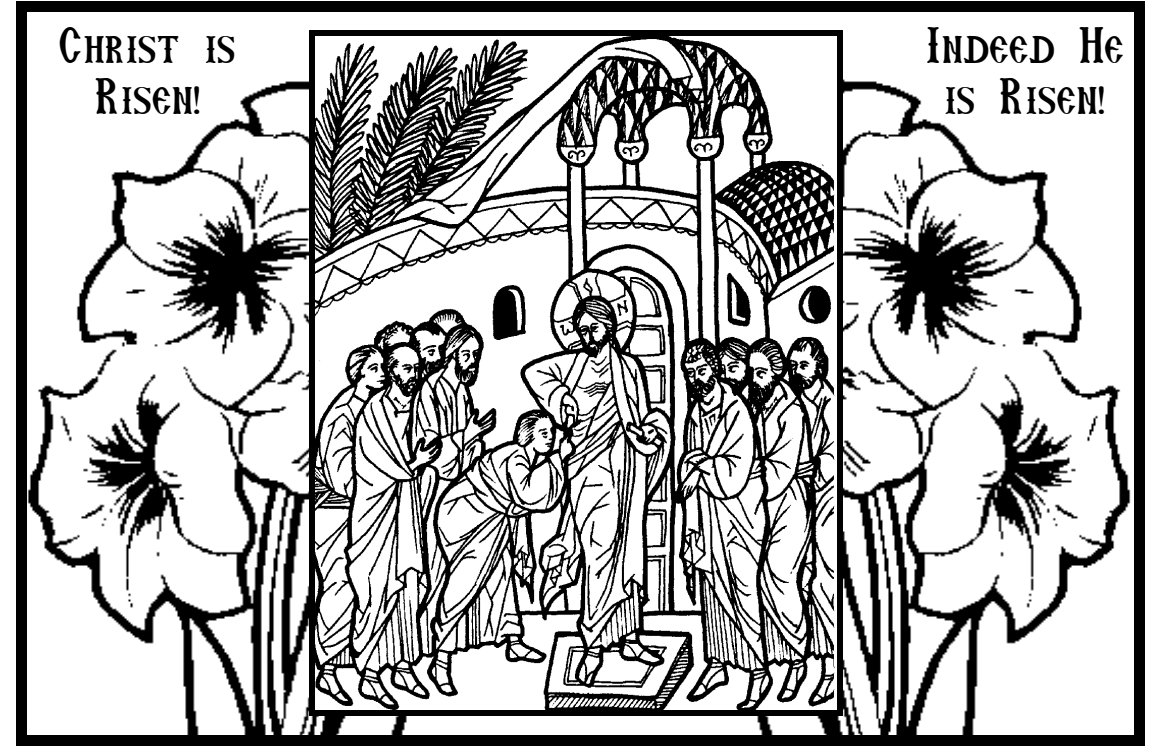

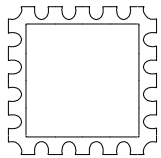

Japanese: *Harisutosu Fukkatsu! Jitsu ni Fukkatsu!*

Romanian: *Cristos a Inviat! Adevarat a Inviat!*
