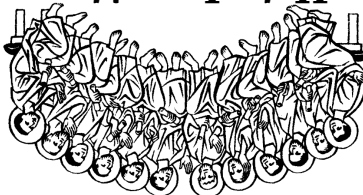

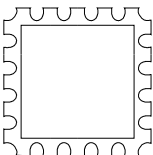

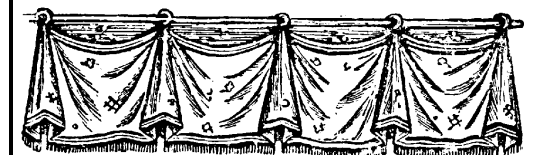

For all parents of young people in our parish: Registration for Church school has begun. Please fill out a registration sheet and return it to Amy

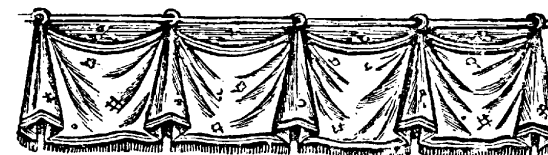
Minarich or Fr. Tim. The first day of Church School is scheduled for Sunday, September 18.
